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# ABOUT COLLEGE

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College of Physiotherapy is located at Viladghat near M.I.D.C. on Nagar – Manamad State Highway, 12 km away from Ahilyanagar bus stand and 20 km from Ahilyanagar Railway Station. The College has beautiful campus and the best infrastructure, which is an excellent expression of modern architecture. It is well connected by the road to Pune (120 km), Aurangabad (120 km) & Nashik (150 km).

DVVPF's College of Physiotherapy is one of the leading educational institutes of Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation Ahilyanagar. It was established on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2007 catering to undergraduate and postgraduate courses in Physiotherapy. The college campus is spread over an area of 42.37 acres of land. The institute is affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Nashik and is approved under section 2(f) of the University Grants Commission (UGC) act, recognized by Government of Maharashtra, Maharashtra State Occupational and Physiotherapy Council, Indian Association of Physiotherapists. It has been accredited by NAAC grade "A' CGPA-3.02 in August 2021.

The curriculum of Physiotherapy course is governed by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences. The curriculum is devised in such a way that, the student after completing B.P.Th. course is efficient to function as a first contact Physiotherapist and also capable to pursue Post Graduate studies or become a research worker if he/she so desires. This is achieved by including in the curriculum, recent trends in Physiotherapy, participation of the students in community health programs to gain first-hand knowledge about community health problems and providing opportunity to do various health related projects.

The faculty members are efficient, experienced, properly trained and care for the students. All the faculty members appeared for staff selection Committee of University for being recognized as University teacher. This makes them eligible for university related works like paper setter, external examiner, committee member, moderator, etc.

The college has adopted student centric teaching-learning processes. It has well qualified, trained, experienced, motivated faculty and also well-developed active Physiotherapy Education Technology Unit. Use of modern teaching aids and tools like computers, audio-visuals, multi-Media, ICT, CAL, digital library with Internet facility both by the teachers and students is encouraged. Learner centric teaching methodology is adopted with emphasis on various methods Of teaching like – seminars, bedside clinics, community based projects, video clips, mannequins and models.

Evaluation of the students is a transparent process and includes subjective as well as objective assessments. Formative assessment with regular examinations and feedback of the students' performance for their improvement is done. The College regularly organizes seminars for under graduate and post Graduate students. The College has provided excellent platform for students and faculty to participate in research.

The institution has significant number of teachers qualified as research guides. Some senior faculties are invited at various conferences as a resource persons and experts. Research is enhanced by collaborations with university. University organizes yearly research activity "AVISHKAR" where students are encouraged to undertake various research projects under the guidance of faculty. Research work of faculty and students has resulted in national & international publications & some books.

The College is always involved in planning various extension activities in order to fulfill the basic goal of creating a 'first contact Physiotherapist' and awareness about social responsibilities in the students. Linkages are established at Deaf and Dumb School, Ahilyanagar, Panchayat Samiti, Rahuri, Leprosy Center, Primary Health Center at Jeur Biajabi, Walki, Mehekari, Dehere, Matoshree Geriatric Home, Vilad Ghat, Firodiya Geriatric Home, Nagar-Aurangabad Road, and Ahilyanagar. Apart from provision of comprehensive health care to the population in the local area, the institute regularly arranges free Physiotherapy camps and awareness campaigns regarding various health related issues.

The students are admitted in our institute from various parts of Maharashtra. There are various student support systems in place due to which dropout rate is minimal. Nearly 90% of the students' progress to further studies or employment. The institution provides financial aid to the needy and deserving students in the form of earn & learn scheme, Book Bank Scheme & also sponsorship for co-curricular activities. Various schemes for student welfare run by the University are successfully implemented by the institute such as Savitribai Phule Scholarship for girl students, Earn & learn Scheme, Dhanvantari Vidyadhan Yojana, etc.

Various committees like Students Guidance unit, cultural committee, Grievance Redressal cell, Anti-ragging committee and the Anti-sexual harassment committee are good support systems for students. The institution prides itself in encouraging our students to participate in sports activities organized at institute level.

The Alumni Association of the college acts as a forum for interaction between the members of faculty and the ex – students. A separate magazine committee with students on the editorial board publishes an annual magazine called "STEPS" that provides a medium for all creative minds.

# STUDENT COUNCIL COMMITTEE

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The Student Council is a group of elected and volunteer students who work together with a staff advisor under a set of rules or bylaws. It provides a platform for student expression, supports school activities, and helps students gain leadership experience. It also strengthens relations between students, faculty, and the community.

The institution has an active Student Council formed as per MUHS guidelines, along with four additional members (2 first-year undergraduate students and 2 postgraduate students). The main role of the council is to present student issues and suggestions to the institution in an organized manner.

The council is formed every year in August/September. The Principal serves as the Chairperson, and a 3rd-year student is appointed as Secretary. Student members are selected as per university rules, and teaching staff are appointed on a rotation basis.

Council meetings are held monthly, ideally in the first week. An agenda is prepared based on student complaints and standard items. In the first meeting of the year, the Principal introduces all members, and the Secretary reads each agenda point for discussion. Record keepers note the points, and the Secretary prepares the minutes after approval by the Principal. Task assignments and compliance reports are then circulated to all students and council members.

The Secretary also prepares notices related to the decisions taken during meetings. One month is given for actions to be completed, and an Action Taken Report is presented in the next meeting along with new agenda points. Any member who remains absent for two consecutive meetings without permission is removed from the council.

At the end of the year, new council members are appointed, and the outgoing Secretary hands over the work file to the next Secretary. This year, 2nd-year students have been given the responsibility of writing down meeting points to support the Secretary in managing minutes, compliance discussions, and current meeting notes.

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
# CULTURAL REPORT -2025
